
"The arrangement of elements within a work of art" (from Tate Modern)





Plan

Brainstorm ideas on your planning sheet



Background

Create your background



Doll

Create your paper doll (with or without a template) and accessories



Cut

Carefully cut out your paper doll using scissors or an X-acto knife (remember to use a cutting mat!)
