

#### Perception

#### **Optical illusion**

something that deceives the eye by appearing to be other than it is

#### Interactive art

"art that relies on the participation of a spectator" (from Tate Modern)

#### Agamograph/lenticular art

"an art form that uses optical illusion to create that changes when you look at it from different angles" (from The ArtsCenter) Today's lesson: lenticular



#### Afrofuturism
